

- Founded in 1905, Fudan is consistently ranked in the top three universities in China, in the top 50 universities globally and number one in Shanghai.
- Fudan University also has 25 subject areas ranked in the world's top 100 universities – with Politics and International Studies ranked 48th in the world and second in China – based on the QS World University Rankings by Subject.
- Of Fudan's approximately 29,000 students, 7,000 are international students from more than 120 different countries.
- The campus combines modern China with the traditions and customs of the university's rich 100-year history. Modern towers complement beautiful Chinese gardens and provide a stimulating and contemplative environment for learning.
- Located in the Yangpu District, north of Shanghai's city center, the
  university is serviced by the city's extensive subway system with a
  train station just a short walk from campus.

- All students on the TEAN China semester program receive language instruction taught to the undergraduate Mandarin language curriculum of the University of Virginia by UVA instructors while they study at Fudan.
- Language class levels are determined by placement examination upon arrival in Shanghai.
