



## UT EDUCATION ABROAD

### *APPLICATION STATUSES FOR SEMESTER PROGRAMS*

Throughout the study abroad application process students will have an application status, which indicates their application progress. This status will change as they complete the different phases of the application. Below are names and descriptions of the statuses that can be assigned to a student application.

STATUS	DESCRIPTION
<b>Pending</b>	This status is not visible to students, only Education Abroad (EA) staff. All students enter this status once they create an application. In pending status, EA advisors verify a student's eligibility to study abroad, and await the submission of all pre-decision application materials by the student.
<b>Pre-Application Submitted</b>	A student has met all eligibility criteria to study abroad and has submitted all pre-decision requirements. The student now has access to all post -decision application requirements.
<b>Accepted</b>	A student has submitted all post-decision application requirements and has been fully accepted into their program. Student will receive their decision letter and can commit to the program.
<b>Committed</b>	A student has acknowledged their decision letter and committed to the program. Student will remain in this status until they go abroad.
<b>Confirmed Abroad</b>	A student has submitted the <i>Confirmation of Arrival Form</i> to verify their contact information while abroad and safe arrival to their study abroad destination.
<b>Confirmed Home</b>	A student has submitted the <i>Confirmation of Return Form</i> to verify they have safely returned home from studying abroad.
<b>Not Approved</b>	A student does not meet eligibility criteria to study abroad.
<b>Waitlist</b>	A student applied for a program that has already met capacity and is put on a waitlist.
<b>Withdrawn</b>	A student notified their EA Advisor that they need to withdraw from their study abroad program.
<b>Awarded</b>	A student has received the UT Education Abroad Scholarship Award for study abroad.
