

UT EDUCATION ABROAD

APPLICATION STATUSES FOR TRAVEL COURSES

Throughout the study abroad application process students will have an application status, which indicates their application progress. This status will change as they complete the different phases of the application. Below are names and descriptions of the statuses that can be assigned to a student application.

STATUS	DESCRIPTION
Pending	This status is not visible to students, only Education Abroad (EA) staff. All students enter this status once they create an application. In pending status, EA advisors verify a student's eligibility to study abroad, and await the submission of predecision application materials.
TC-Eligibility Met -Deposit Needed	A student has met eligibility criteria to study abroad. A program deposit is required along with the submission of all pre-decision application requirements located in student's application.
<i>TC</i> – Deposit Received	A student has successfully made their deposit for the Travel Course and submitted all pre-decision application requirements.
TC- Final Payment Received	A student made the final Travel Course payment and submitted all post-decision application requirements. The student has been accepted into the program, however is pending faculty leader approval. Student will receive their decision letter and can commit to the program.
Committed	A student has acknowledged their decision letter and committed to the program. Student will remain in this status until they go abroad.
TC- Course Traveled	A student is currently on a Travel Course.
TC- Course Canceled	The Travel Course has been cancelled due to low enrollment or extenuating circumstances.
Not Approved	A student does not meet the eligibility criteria to study abroad.
Waitlist	A student applied for a program that has already met capacity and is put on a waitlist.
Withdrawn	A student notified their EA Advisor that they need to withdraw from their study abroad program.
